1. Rewrite prayer: Read Wisdom 9:1-11, Solomon’s prayer of wisdom. Rewrite these verses in contemporary English. (C-13)
2. Proverb: Create your own proverb that addresses an injustice. Design a plaque with the saying on it. (C-13)
3. Cross: The cross is a powerful symbol of death and resurrection, suffering and joy. Create your own cross using any medium you wish .(C-14)
4. Exile letter: Write a letter or a journal entry from the point of view of a Jewish person in exile or a Jewish person who has returned to Jerusalem after the exile. (C-15)
5. “Vision of Dry Bones”: Illustrate the part of Ezekiel’s vision that is the most interesting to you. (p. 198 in text and Ezekiel 37:1-14 in Bible.) (C-15)
6. Job song: Write a song about Job and his troubles. (C-16)
7. Book of Job: Reading the Book of Job can reinforce that prayer requires faith and persistence. Each tragedy severely tests Job’s faith. Job continues to speak with God and eventually Job’s faith is rewarded. Write a brief summary and illustrate ONE of the following passages from Job:
  - a. The first trial Job, 1:13-22

- b. The Lord's speech, Job 38:1-11
  - c. Job's answer, Job 42:1-6
- 8. Sabbath: During the Exodus God commanded the Israelites to always honor the Sabbath. As Catholics, we, too, are called to honor the Sabbath. Even though our lives are busy, it is very important that we make an effort to celebrate the Sabbath. Get copy of p. 18 from Mrs. C and complete it with your family. (C-15)
- 9. Scroll of Esther: Reread "A prayer for her people" p. 210 in text and Esther A chapters 2-8 in Bible. On the Jewish holiday of Purim, the scroll of Esther is read to celebrate the Jews' deliverance from destruction. Choose an event from Esther's story to illustrate. Roll up in a scroll. (Get paper from Mrs. C) (C-16)
